

Information Required by the Yorkshire Ambulance Service Once an External Defibrillator Cabinet has been Fitted and AED Installed

Once the cabinet has been fitted, connected to the electricity supply and the defibrillator put inside the Ambulance Service require certain information to make the site 'live' on their system.

This will allow the Ambulance Service call taker to advise the caller of exactly where the defibrillator is kept and how to access it.

- **Village/Town name.**
- **Site name i.e. Village Hall, Flying Horse Inn, Community Centre etc.**
- **Site Address.**
- **Site postcode.**
- **Exact location of defibrillator cabinet i.e. next to main entrance, wall facing carpark...**
- **Cabinet lock code.**
- **Guardian name.**
- **Guardian contact no's – landline/mobile.**
- **Guardian email address.**
- **Any other information you think might be relevant and worth noting such as if the site is difficult to find etc.**
- **Type of AED, serial number.**
