

Information Required by the Yorkshire Ambulance Service Once an AED has been Installed

Once your location has installed a defibrillator the Ambulance Service requires certain information to make the site show 'live' on their system.

This will allow the Ambulance Service call taker to advise the caller of exactly where the defibrillator is kept and how to access it.

Please can you email the following information to: **Dave.Jones@yas.nhs.uk**

- **Site name.**
- **Site Address.**
- **Site postcode.**
- **Direct telephone call back number (for use in event of AED activation. This should ideally be a direct number and not one that has options).**
- **Exact location of defibrillator i.e. First Aid Room, Reception area etc.**
- **Name of person responsible for checking the device.**
- **Above named persons contact no's – landline/mobile.**
- **Above named persons email address.**
- **Any other information you think might be relevant and worth noting i.e. type of AED etc.**
